POLICY AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING BEAVER MEADOW GOLF COURSE

Thank you for becoming a member of Beaver Meadow Golf Course and we hope you have an enjoyable golf season. This facility is available to the public, and in its endeavor to assist and guide participants, the Parks and Recreation Department has adopted the following policies and procedures:

- a. Every Member and player must register in the Pro Shop before beginning play and will be assigned a starting place. All players must follow the directions of the Pro Shop, Starter-Ranger or bona fide City Official
- b. There are no Membership refunds except for bona fide health reasons.
- c. Beaver Meadow has a full service restaurant that is open daily and provides an on course beverage cart for the consumption of food, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages. The city of Concord prohibits anyone or any group from bringing their own food, alcoholic, and non-alcoholic beverages onto the golf course for consumption or re-sale, without written permission from the Golf Course manager or his designee.
- d. Tee Times are available 7 days a week. All players will be grouped into threesomes and/or foursomes whenever possible. Five-somes will be at the discretion of the Pro Shop and/or the Starter-Ranger
- e. No player is allowed to play more than one ball at any time. Practicing is allowed in designated areas only.
- f. Players are expected to keep pace on the golf course. Please use designated tees, replace divots, repair ball marks, and smooth sand traps. All players are asked to exercise proper golf etiquette.
- g. All players must wear proper attire. Non metal golf shoes or sneakers must be worn. No bare feet, no soccer or football cleats. Golf shirts and Bermuda shorts are acceptable. Any attire deemed inappropriate will need to be changed before paly begins.
- h. Spectators are not allowed anywhere on the course except by special permission of the Golf Course Manager or his designee. Caddies are allowed and must register in the Pro Shop. Caddies are not allowed to play golf while caddying.
- i. Golf bags, Pull and Push carts, and Golf Cars must be kept off tees, greens and aprons. Golf Cars must follow all signs, directions and follow paths where provided. Individuals with walking disabilities or other special needs should note such to the Pro Shop and/or the Starter-Ranger and every reasonable accommodation will be made.
- j. The golf course may be closed for designated tournaments or golf course maintenance at the discretion of the Golf Course Manager or his designee.
- k. None of these policies noted supersede or replace items outlined in the Policy and Procedure Manual for Beaver Meadow Golf Course, adopted and revised by the Golf Advisory Committee, as appointed by Concord City Council, 2012. Said Manual is available at www.BeaaverMeadowGolfCourse.com, in the Clubhouse and by request.

Failure to comply with policies and procedures may result in the loss of Playing and/or Golf Car privileges. No refunds will be given.
